

# FAQ's

**1. What are the grant requirements?**

The grant requires that you align with the goals of ReCAST; submit a final report; attend the kick-off meeting and year-end convening.

**2. What is the project period?**

The project period is from April 2024 –September 2024.

**3. Can you apply multiple times with different nonprofits?**

Yes, you are allowed to submit applications for more than one nonprofit organization.

**4. When will awards be announced?**

Awards will be announced in early March 2024.

**5. When will the funds dispersed?**

Contracts will be executed by April 1, 2024.

**6. What percentage of youth need to be Flint residents?**

The majority of the population served should be Flint residents.

**7. How do you write an effective Request For Proposal (RFP)?**

In order to write an effective RFP, respond to the questions posed. Provide clear explanation of the proposed programming, organization, proposed outcomes, and proposed budget.

**8. What could cause a proposal to be denied?**

A proposal may be denied due to, a lack of information, not responding to/addressing the questions, unclear budget, or not including all of the required attachments.

**9. Is the grant renewable?**

The grant is not renewable, but you may apply again during the next grant cycle.

## **10. How can I build relationships with community partners and stakeholders?**

If you are interested in building relationships there is a Community Advisory Board (CAB), openings may arise at the end of this year (October 2024). The CAB will begin holding a public meeting each quarter, starting in the third quarter of 2024. There is also a Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC) committee that has openings. The STRONG Summit will take place in May 2024 where many community members and stakeholders are encouraged and invited to attend.
