A retired businessman, he joined NAMI as a volunteer in 2011 after his oldest son was diagnosed with a mental illness in late 2007 and was lost to suicide in 2010. Kevin is also the Founder and Director of The Dominique Fischer Memorial Foundation, CEO of EverybodyVsStigma.com, Past-President of Crisis Intervention Team International, member of Governor Whitmer’s Suicide Prevention Commission, member of the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services Mental Health Diversion Council and Behavioral Health Advisory Council, and recipient of NAMI’s 2022 Vicki Cottrell Award.
